It's that time of year! We're looking for parent volunteers to lead class auction projects. Class projects are featured in the live auction and all are welcome to bid on them. Class projects generate between \$500 - \$5000 depending on the item and are a highlight of the evening.

You'll be asked to complete a class project that will be featured in the live auction on Saturday, April 29th.

- **Projects will be due no later than April 10th.** Descriptions and pictures will be needed for the auction catalog and slide show.
- **Each class has already been allocated \$20.00 per student** for the project budget. Example: a class of 20 would have a \$400 budget. Receipts are turned in to our bookkeeper for reimbursement.

Examples and pictures of previous class projects are posted on the schools PTL Facebook page (you can use the group search tool to find them). Pinterest is also great for inspiration.

Please let us know what your plan is before beginning the project so we can avoid duplicates and offer suggestions based on previous experience.

Tina Bowers (7th grade parent) has volunteered to be our Class Project Coordinator. She will contact volunteers and teachers to make sure each class will be represented, answer questions, collect pictures and descriptions, and assist with the class project display.

Additional ideas:

- Put together a large class basket with wide appeal
- Same grade classes may choose to pair up
- Collect additional donations to add to the project
- Offer experiences with smaller personalized items from the class:

- Day at the Beach "basket" with items placed in a cooler and personalized outdoor blanket or sun umbrella.
- A weekend family stay at a hotel or Airbnb with smaller basket and class memory book or personalized game.

Have fun and be creative! You're more than welcome to team up with other class parents and the teacher to discuss ideas and delicate tasks. This can easily be a team effort with your leadership. Projects should be something anyone would want to bid on while including some student personalization or a smaller personalized item to accompany the main project.
